


Mandarin Phrasebook & Dictionary by Lonely Planet:


China in the 21st Century by Jeffery N. Wasserstrom:


Out of Mao's Shadow by Philip P. Pan:



Broken into three sections, The Great Wall provides an overview that debunks myths and dishes up rare facts and figures, a comprehensive history that proceeds dynasty by dynasty through its construction, and an account of Lindesay's personal experiences of the Wall.
